Dear Friend of Our Lady,

As you will see in this letter and upon reading the enclosed article, Sister Lucy's words in the above quote are very pertinent for today.

We must [pray the Rosary](#) if we are to have a chance at eternal salvation!

The [Fatima Center Rapid Response team](#) just returned from Lund, Sweden.

We went there for six days to witness to the true Catholic Faith and to make reparation for the Pope's trip to Sweden to "commemorate" the approaching 500<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the heretic Luther and his progeny - that led, and continues to lead, millions down the road to perdition - the Lutheran Church.

Why Sweden, and why the relatively small city of Lund, located in the southern part of the country? It is the home of the Lutheran Federation founded in 1947.

Before the Lutheran Revolt against the Catholic Church in the 1500s there were 27 Catholic churches in Lund. But when the Protestants (Lutherans in this case) stole all the Catholic property, including all the churches, they destroyed many of the sacred images in the churches and the church buildings as well.

In Lund, of the 27 Catholic churches that existed before the revolution, the Lutherans pillaged and destroyed 25. There are still two remaining church buildings which the Church of Sweden considers to be Lutheran churches.

One is called the Cathedral of Lund that dates back to the 1100s. The other is St. Peter's Priory, established before 1166 for Benedictine nuns. It was originally dedicated to Saint Mary and Saint Peter (Sankta Marias och Sankt Peters Klosters Kyrka aka Klosterkyrkan), but by 1200 it was simply referred to as St. Peter's Priory.

It was in the Cathedral of Lund that Pope Francis participated in an ecumenical inter-religious service. This act

is completely outside of Catholic teaching and calls down Our Lord's just punishment.

The wide-spread publishing of the Pope's planned trip and his subsequent journey to Sweden for this diabolical event potentially misled millions around the world - Catholics and non-Catholics alike - into thinking that it is acceptable to be Lutheran, or that one does not have to be Catholic to be saved.

These are heresies that violate the infallible, unchangeable Catholic dogmas of the Faith that no one, not even a Pope, can change.

Our Lady of Fatima warned that each one of us must amend our lives and lead a truly Catholic life, or we will not be saved. She also asked that we offer sacrifices for sinners - that they may turn from their sinful ways and convert.

The reasons some Fatima Center staff went to Sweden - a country that is not Catholic, and is historically very anti-Catholic - were:

-To defend the rights of Christ the King and His One True Church;

-To make reparation for sin - in this case the sin of heresy;

-To remind the Pope of his duty to uphold Catholic teaching and not compromise the One True Faith;

-To remind the Pope of his duty to obey Our Lady of Fatima and consecrate Russia to Her Immaculate Heart;

### **With Burning Concern ...**

Enclosed with this letter is a *Catholic Family News* (CFN) Reprint, "[With Burning Concern: We Accuse Pope Francis.](#)"

The content is not pretty, and is upsetting to those of us who love our Catholic Faith, and certainly will be a shock and source of upset for those who are not aware of what has been happening in the Church. I stress that it is factual information, right from the Pope's own writings and words, so one can check the information first-hand.

In the last two years The Fatima Center has understandably received phone calls, emails and postal mail asking about the

Pope and questioning the many things he is quoted as saying in the media.

Initially many made excuses, thinking that the media must be misquoting the Pope, or that the translation from one language to another must have resulted in error. But after many such events, it became apparent this was not the case. And eventually some Vatican spokespersons began confirming the accuracy of the media in quoting the Pope's words.

Many of the quotes are directly or indirectly against the perennial, infallible teachings of the Catholic Faith. During the course of the last two years, as you may recall, The Fatima Center has sent new leaflets to supporters which address some of the areas of the Faith that have come under attack by the Pope and other members of the Church hierarchy.

The reason for the leaflets is to remind our apostolate supporters that no matter what the Pope or any other Catholic clergyman might say, here is Catholic teaching as given to us by Our Lord Jesus Christ, on these issues that seemingly are being called into question.

Here are some of the leaflets produced by The Fatima Center that have addressed these pertinent issues being attacked by certain Church hierarchy:

- [Defend the Family](#) - This was sent to North American and other supporters, including priests, and it was translated and distributed in Italy last Fall during the Synod, which was an attack on the family and the Sacrament of Matrimony.
- [Pope Benedict, "Gender Theory" and the Threat to Civilization leaflet](#) - another area of Church teaching that is under attack. This area deals with one of the sins that cry to Heaven for vengeance, the sin of sodomy.
- [St. John Bosco on Mohammedanism](#) - Our Lady's apostolate volunteers were the first to receive this leaflet - so pertinent for our time.

The reason for the leaflet is that certain clergy within the Church are giving the false impression that (among other things):

- *Muslims are peace-loving people.* Those who are actively practicing the Muslim belief system cannot be peace-loving since the religion was started in, and teaches, violence. Among other things, it instructs Muslims to kill the mushriks - we are the mushriks - that is, anyone who does not believe in 'allah');
- *Muslims pray to the same God.* They don't, it is not the same. Not only do they not believe that Jesus Christ is God, but they also blaspheme Our Lord in their "sacred book", the Quran [Koran], and they do not believe in the Trinity;

- *Muslims do not have to convert to Catholicism in order to be saved. Yes they do, and that is where we come in with regard to the requests of Our Lady of Fatima to offer sacrifices for sinners - which includes sacrifices for the conversion of non-Catholics;*

- [Genuine Mercy and Counterfeit Compassion](#) leaflet - It would be good to get well versed with the content of this leaflet which explains what true or genuine mercy is.

You will need this if you distribute the other leaflets mentioned in this letter. There is a false idea of mercy which unfortunately many clergymen are promoting. Genuine mercy and genuine charity are about telling people the truth and not falsely misleading them into thinking they can be saved even if living sinful lives (not in the state of grace) or even if they are not Catholic.

The enclosed *CFN* reprint, "[With Burning Concern: We Accuse Pope Francis](#)", gives an overview of the many areas of Catholic teaching - areas that are unchangeable - that are being attacked directly or indirectly by Pope Francis and some other members of the Church hierarchy.

In order to work toward our own salvation and the salvation of those whom God places on our path, we must understand that (to the delight of enemies outside the Church) the Faith is being attacked from within the Church. And we must know what those areas under attack are.

Pope Francis' frequent statements which are contrary to Catholic teaching of 2,000 years are misleading millions of Catholics. And Catholics must do their part to defend the rights of Christ the King and His One True Church, the Catholic Church.
