

THE JOYFUL MYSTERIES

Mondays and Thursdays (also Sundays from beginning of Advent until Lent)

1. The Annunciation

MEDITATION: And when the angel had come to Her, he said, "Hail, full of grace, the Lord is with Thee, blessed art Thou among women." Luke 1,28



2. The Visitation

MEDITATION: And Elizabeth was filled with the Holy Ghost, and cried out with a loud voice saying, "Blessed art Thou among women and blessed is the fruit of Thy womb!"

Luke 1, 41-42



3. Birth of Jesus

MEDITATION: And She brought forth Her firstborn Son, and wrapped Him in swaddling clothes, and laid Him in a manger, because there was no room for Them in the inn.

Luke 2, 7



4. The Presentation

MEDITATION: And when the days of Her purification were fulfilled according to the Law of Moses, they took Him up to Jerusalem to present Him to the Lord.

Luke 2, 22



5. Finding Jesus in the Temple

MEDITATION: And it came to pass after three days, that they found Him in the temple, sitting in the midst of the teachers, both listening to them and asking them questions.

Luke 2, 46




THE SORROWFUL MYSTERIES

Tuesdays and Fridays (also Sundays during Lent)

1. The Agony in the Garden

MEDITATION: And His sweat became as drops of blood running down upon the ground. And rising from prayer He came to the disciples, and found them sleeping for sorrow. Luke 22, 44-45



2. The Scourging at the Pillar

MEDITATION: Pilate then, took Jesus and had Him scourged. John 19, 1 But He was wounded for our iniquities, He was bruised for our sins: the chastisement of our peace was upon Him, and by His bruises we are healed.

Isaias 53.5



3. The Crowning with Thorns

MEDITATION: And they stripped Him and put on Him a scarlet cloak; and plaiting a crown of thorns, they put it on His head, and a reed into His right hand.

Matt. 27, 28-29



4. The Carrying of the Cross

MEDITATION: And bearing the Cross for Himself, He went forth to the place called Calvary; in Hebrew, Golgotha.

John 19, 17



5. The Crucifixion

MEDITATION: And Jesus cried out with a loud voice and said, "Father, into Thy hands I commend My spirit." And having said this, He expired.

Wednesdays and Saturdays (also Sundays from Easter until Advent)

1. The Resurrection

MEDITATION: He has risen. He is not here. Behold the place where they laid Him.

Mark 16, 6



2. The Ascension

MEDITATION: So then the Lord, after He had spoken to them, was taken up into Heaven, and sits at the right hand of God.

Mark 16, 19



3. The Descent of the Holy Ghost

MEDITATION: And suddenly there came a sound from Heaven, as of a mighty wind coming, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting.

Acts 2, 2



4. The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin

MEDITATION: And I took root in an honorable people, and in the portion of My God His inheritance, and My abode is in the full assembly of saints.

Ecclus. 24: 16




5. Mary is Crowned Queen of Heaven and Earth
