Faithful Catholics share in a pain that few others understand.

We worry to the point of anguish that our loved ones could end up in hell.

Our secular society encourages the lifestyles of our wayward loved ones. Even worse, many are now feeling abandoned by their shepherds. Churches are closed. Sacraments are restricted. Some prelates openly promote heresies and immorality, all the while teaching that hell is empty.

At Fatima, Our Lady provided us with a "secret weapon" that is particularly effective in the epic battle for the souls of our loved ones. During Her second apparition at Fatima, on June 13, 1917, She told the children that Our Lord wills to establish in the world devotion to Her Immaculate Heart.

The Immaculate Heart of Mary is our refuge and will lead the souls of our loved ones to God.

During Her fourth apparition, on August 19, 1917, Our Lady said something extraordinary: "Pray! Pray a great deal and make sacrifices for sinners, for many souls go to hell because they have no one to pray and make sacrifices for them." Our prayers and sacrifices, or lack thereof, help determine whether many souls, including those of our loved ones, will spend eternity in Heaven or hell.

Yet worrying about our family members and friends and having warm feelings towards the Immaculate Heart is not enough. We must take concrete and consistent action to counter the efforts of the devil, the flesh and the world and help win the battle for their souls.

Our Lord tells us the parable of the widow who continually beseeched a judge to give her justice (see Luke 18: 1-8). The judge finally relented out of weariness from the widow's 'troublesome pestering.' The Gospel explains that Our Lord told this parable so that we might always pray and not lose heart. Let us be confident that Our Lord and Our Lady will never forsake us but will instead reward our consistent efforts on behalf of our loved ones with the salvation of their souls.
