
CONTROVERSIAL ISSUES

1 THE CONSECRATION OF RUSSIA: Heaven requested the Consecration of Russia to the Immaculate Heart of Mary by the Pope in union with all the Catholic bishops in a solemn public ceremony on a day of worldwide reparation. On at least fourteen occasions since 1942, the Popes have responded incompletely. The Vatican claimed Pope John Paul II fulfilled Our Lady's request in 1984. Some now claim Pope Francis did so in March 2022. On both occasions, the Pope consecrated the whole world, not Russia as the sole object of consecration; did not require the bishops to join him; and did not call for reparation. Our Lady promised that the conversion of Russia and world peace would follow as direct effects of the consecration. Neither has occurred. Heaven still awaits the proper Consecration of Russia.

2 THE THIRD SECRET: The Vatican did not release the Third Secret of Fatima by 1960. Instead, it issued a press release stating that "it is most likely that the letter will never be opened, in which Sr. Lucia wrote down the words which Our Lady confided as a secret to the three little shepherds."

In June 2000, the Vatican published what it said was the entire Third Secret. In the text, Lucia describes a mysterious vision in which the Holy Father, "half trembling with [a] halting step" and "afflicted with pain and sorrow," passes "through a big city half in ruins," praying "for the souls of the corpses" he meets



on the way. As he kneels at the foot of a large wooden cross, he is killed by soldiers, as are faithful of every rank. The text contains no words spoken by Our Lady.

Abundant evidence suggests there is more to the Third Secret. Lucia wrote down the Secret in two documents, only one of which has been released by the Vatican. The other document is a one-page letter, which Fatima scholars believe contains the words of Our Lady and likely refers to the crisis of faith that has engulfed the Church since the Second Vatican Council and material and spiritual chastisements yet to come. We await the release of the entire Third Secret.

WHY SHOULD WE BELIEVE?

- The Message of Fatima was authenticated by the Miracle of the Sun a public miracle without precedent. The date and place of the miracle were foretold months in advance and it was witnessed by tens of thousands believers and unbelievers alike. Fatima is no mere private revelation. In 1982, Pope John Paul II said: "The Message of Fatima imposes an obligation on the whole Church."
- The Church has formally approved the authenticity of the Fatima apparitions. In 1930, after an extensive investigation, the Bishop of Leiria, in which Fatima is located, declared that the visions of the children "are worthy of belief."
- On May 13, 2017, Francisco and Jacinta were canonized. They are the youngest Catholic saints who are not martyrs. The process for Lucia's canonization is currently under way.
- All the Popes since 1917 have endorsed the authenticity of the apparitions and the Fatima Message. In 2010, Pope Benedict XVI said: "He deceives himself who thinks that the prophetic mission of Fatima is concluded."

WHAT SHOULD WE DO?

The Fatima Message is Heaven's solution – and the only solution – for the crisis besetting us. It is never too late to have recourse to Jesus and Mary.

When devotion to the Immaculate Heart of Mary is established by the practice of the First Saturday devotion and the Consecration of Russia, Russia will convert to the Catholic Faith and peace will reign. Until then, the crisis will worsen, leading to the annihilation of nations and the loss of many souls.

To obtain the graces necessary for the proper Consecration of Russia and the Triumph of the Immaculate Heart, we must do what Our Lady of Fatima requested:

- [1] CEASE OFFENDING GOD and stay in the state of grace;
- 2 Pray the ROSARY daily;
- [3] Practice the FIRST SATURDAY devotion monthly;
- [4] Be enrolled in and wear the BROWN SCAPULAR;
- **5 OFFER PRAYERS** and **SACRIFICES**, especially our daily duty well performed, in reparation for sin and for the conversion of sinners;
- [6] CONSECRATE ourselves to the Immaculate Heart of Mary; and
- [7] Pray and sacrifice for the Pope and bishops to consecrate Russia as requested by Heaven.

Time is short; we must act now!


